**APPLICATION FOR
 DUAL REGISTRATION**

An AMHA registration may be recorded pursuant to Rule 1 - Section 2 of the Registry Rules and Regulation:

This form is to be used when a Canadian/British registered Morgan is physically located in the U.S.A. and AMHA registration is required **OR**, to accomplish dual registration of a registered Morgan residing in Canada or Great Britain.

Instructions:

1. Print in ink or type only.
2. The Canadian/British registration must be recorded in the applicant's name.
3. A copy of the Canadian/British certificate of registration must be submitted with this application.
4. A fee of \$30 US DOLLARS must be submitted for the subject horse.
5. A fee of \$30 US DOLLARS must also be submitted for each ancestor in the subject's pedigree that is not registered with the AMHA up to a maximum of ten ancestors or \$300 US DOLLARS.

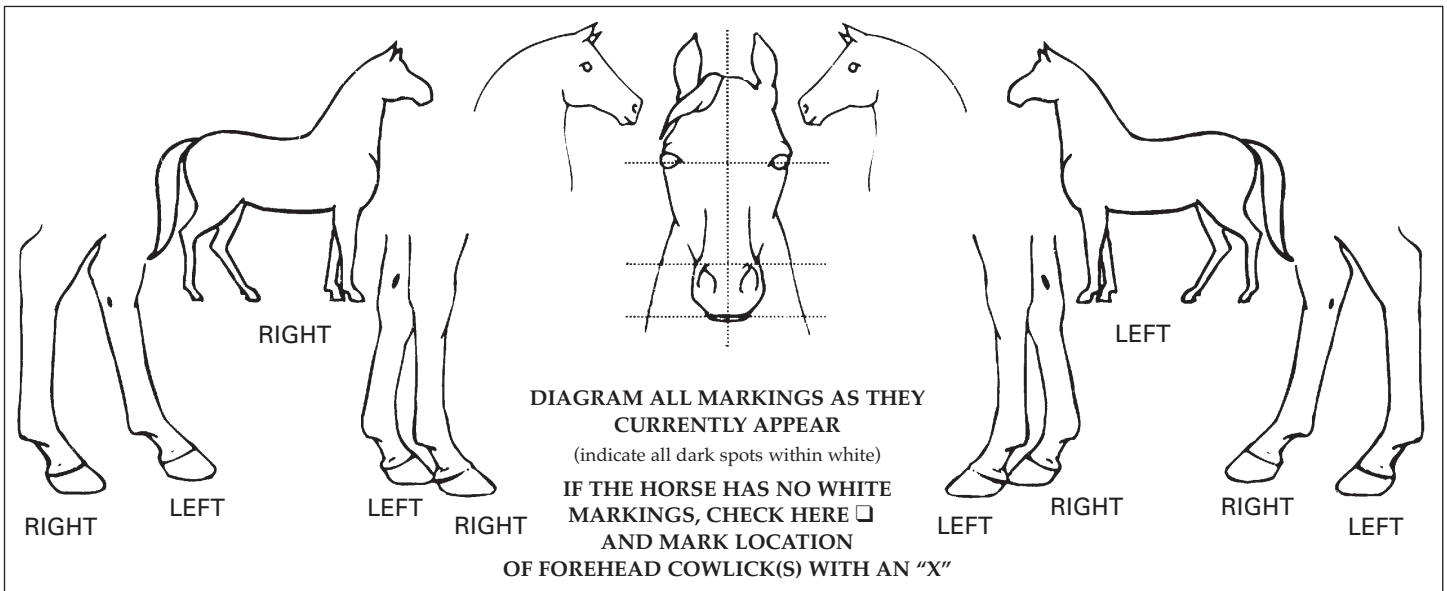

Step E (below) must be completed for all horses with no white markings.

DRAW MARKINGS IN PEN, NOT PENCIL • DO NOT USE WHITE-OUT!

- A. On the diagram above, outline all of the markings of the horse being registered.
- B. Complete the diagrams with the horse in front of you. Do not trust to memory or hearsay.
- C. Include any scars or brands the horse may have that might be helpful in identifying the horse.
- D. Clear photographs of the marking may help speed processing, especially for horses that have unusual markings.
- E. Mark the location of the forehead cowlick(s) (hair whorl) with an X. Indicate accurately if to the right/left or above/below the guidelines.
